

West Australian Orff Schulwerk Association Code of Conduct

The WAOSA Code of Conduct requires members and their appointed delegates (both ordinary and co-opted) to comply with the following in connection with all WAOSA activities;

- behave honestly and with integrity;
- act with care and diligence;
- treat everyone with respect and courtesy, and without harassment;
- comply with all applicable Commonwealth and State laws;
- identify and disclose any potential conflicts of interest;
- use ANCOS resources in a proper manner and for a proper purpose;
- provide true and accurate information in response to any request made for official purposes;
- behave in a way that upholds the mission, integrity and good reputation of WAOSA;
- uphold the Code of Conduct in all forms of communication (including digital);
- represent WAOSA and Australia (both nationally and internationally) in a way that upholds the good reputation of WAOSA;
- uphold the principles and their intent as expressed in the WAOSA constitution;
- comply with any other conduct requirement that may be prescribed by WAOSA.

Violations of the WAOSA Code of Conduct

• any alleged breach of this Code of Conduct will be dealt with in accordance with the dispute resolution process in the WAOSA constitution.
